**D**wayne Haught started working in the HIV/AIDS field in 1983 and has focused on HIV/AIDS research, education, and development of community-based HIV/AIDS care. He helped found the David Powell HIV Clinic in Austin and developed the first HIV Specialty Women's Clinic in Central Texas. He also served as a member of the Austin HIV Planning Council.

Since 2001, Mr. Haught has served as Program Manager for the Texas HIV/AIDS Medication Program (Texas' AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)). He also manages the Texas State Pharmacy Assistance Program.

Dwayne's leadership extends to the national level. He provided training and technical assistance on Medicare Part D to Ryan White programs across the Nation, in partnership with HRSA and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

During Hurricane Katrina, Dwayne worked with HRSA and Ryan White grantees in Louisiana and Mississippi to ensure continued access to medications for dislocated clients. He worked with the Fair Pricing Coalition to successfully encourage drug manufacturers to develop co-pay assistance programs for privately insured clients, and is an active member of the National ADAP Crisis Task Force. Dwayne also serves as a technical assistance consultant for HRSA on an array of ADAP issues.
