**J**ane Caruso has worked in the HIV field for nearly 30 years. She is currently the Ryan White Part D Project Director for the New Jersey Statewide Family Centered HIV Care Network. Consisting of seven sites, the Network is a leading force in providing care to women, children, youth, and families infected and affected by HIV disease in the State. Since 2003, Ms. Caruso has played a pivotal role in coordinating and guiding the seven Network sites as it has undertaken a significant number of activities and initiatives to improve access to care, reduce barriers, and ensure services are provided in accordance with treatment guidelines.

Jane also serves as the Team Leader of the New Jersey Cross-Part Quality Improvement Collaborative. In this role, she serves as New Jersey's central convener and shepherds the process. Participation in the 18-month Collaborative involves bi-monthly reporting on key performance measures, implementation of quality improvement projects, and coordination of efforts across the state. The team's success was recently highlighted in a national meeting by the HRSA Center for Quality showcasing their unique success story.
